Twiss Green has supported Mwanjati Village School Trust for many years. The charity was formed to help children in a village called Mwanjati, which is situated in Mangochi district, Southern Region of Malawi. Together, Twiss Green and the charity have successfully raised funds to support the school, including building additional classrooms. Amongst other things, our fundraising efforts in the past have included cake sales and our children collecting spare change in Mwanjati money boxes. Due to the pandemic, many of our fund raising activities ceased. However, we are now keen to relaunch our support for Mwanjati. We have begun by asking our Year 6 children to write letters to the children of Mwanjati and hope to receive some replies soon! We will also be holding two cake sales this term, on the 18th May and the 6th July and will be thinking very carefully about what our support could look like next year.
