SEND

Thank you to all that completed the SEND parent questionnaire (sent to those families with children on our SEND register). We are pleased to share some of the feedback that we received.

Most parents feel that we give their child positive opportunities such as after school activities, educational visits and residentials, being on the school/class council, amongst others.

Most parents feel that their child is making progress at school and know how they are supported to make progress. They recognise this as being through the sharing of their child's learning plan termly, meetings/conversations with their child's class teacher and/or SENCo, emails, phone calls and parents' evening.

All parents say that they have been offered opportunities to discuss their child with the class teacher/SENCo at least termly.

Nearly all parents say that they have spoken to the class teacher/SENCo about their child's SEND needs.

Most parents say that they have confidence in the Governors and Senior Leadership team in regard to provision for SEND in school.

We appreciate the time parents have taken to fill in the questionnaires and we will be asking for feedback again in the Autumn term. In the meantime, we would like to hear any further thoughts about how we could improve and if you have any specific concerns. Please get in touch. We will send a Google form over the coming days, where you can add this.

If any parent is concerned about their child and any barriers they may have to learning, we recommend that you speak to your child's class teacher in the first instance. You may then want to follow this up with the SENCo - Susan Puckey. If you feel that your concerns are not resolved, then you may wish to contact the Headteacher. If again, you feel that your concerns have not been resolved, you may wish to contact the SEND Governor - Claire Strange. Contact details are on the school website or please contact the office.
