## Forgiveness in the Bible

Bible Story	Where can I find it?	What does it teach Christians?
Creation	Genesis 1	That God created everything to work together in harmony. It was a very good creation.
Adam and Eve	Genesis 3	When people give into temptation and to the wrong thing, they have to face the consequences of their actions. They should never disobey their God.
Parable of the Lost Son	Luke 15: 11-32	God will forgive them if they are willing to be humble and own up to their mistakes.

### Avoiding evil and temptation

#### **The Lords Prayer**

Christians say this prayer often when they ask for forgiveness. They ask God to protect them from temptation and evil.

To help them avoid evil and temptation, Christians follow the rules as set out in the 10 commandments.

Obey your parents.

Do not hurt others with words or actions.

Reep your promises to others and God.
